
A former power station

Before 2006: complex building:


- different levels

Method

Evaluation of 14 solutions

- mapping of the process

empirical data:

- Interviews; the architect, the public assessibility advisor
- Emails with questions; the owner, local building authority
- Visit
- Source material; architectural drawings, minutes, emails

Our expectation

Hypothesis:

the different solutions of accessibility would be depending on factors as:

- construction of the building
- cultural heritage/architecture
- economy



The owner = the municipality: A new disability policy 2008 + accessibility adviser


The architect, 2008, a note:
