


### National action plan 2009 -13

 Coordinated by the Ministry of Children, Equality and Social inclusion.

- Nearly 200 steps on crossector areas

- Nearly all ministries involved
- Focus on buildings, outdor areas, planning and ICT
- The sector approach basic
- Evaluation result:
   no fullfilled sector approach and
   local policy without an action plan





## National action plan 2009 -13

Focus on municipal centres and areas

#### Goal:

- all municipals centres in Norway are to be universally designed
- all municipals centres are to have outdoor areas for general use that are universally designed




